WHAT WE ARE LEARNING

MATH: Module 1: Foundations for Multiplication: We will continue to work on division, and its relationship to multiplication. We will also discuss the *commutative property* of multiplication (5x2 gives the same answer as 2x5).

ELA/WRITING: Comprehension Skill: Author's Point of View: We will discuss point of view, and how we can tell what an author thinks about something by looking closely at the words and detail the author uses in the text. We will use the reading: "Desert Meerkats" to examine author's point of view.

Last week we learned how to write a multiparagraph essay on a certain topic. The kids tried typing it on Google Docs without writing it down in pencil first. This week we will continue to examine paragraphs and how they are structured.
