REGISTRATION INFORMATION:

- 1. Complete the Registration Card. Your school counselor's signature is required for enrollment.
- 2. Return the Registration Card to your counselor **no later than Friday, May 22nd, 2015**. Confirmation of enrollment will be sent by June 8th, 2015. Students who register after May 22nd, 2015 cannot be assured of enrollment.
- 3. Students should register promptly and <u>choose alternative classes</u> on enrollment Registration Card. Do not wait until the deadline because space is limited!

GENERAL POLICY AND PROCEDURES: Please See Informational Flyer

ATTENDANCE: Students enrolled in the "**Credit Recovery**" classes must stay on pacing guide in order to finish their first course by end session 1 (July 9th) and then will be able to enroll in second course. Students may enroll in second course starting session 2 (July 13th-30th) Students enrolled in "**Credit Recovery**" classes may work online in alternative settings as well as in a summer school designated classroom. *MANDATORY* attendance in a summer school designated classroom for all students behind pacing guides.

Students enrolled in the "**Grade Recovery Full Course**" classes MUST attend summer school daily Monday-Thursday, 8:00a.m.-1:00p.m. Session 1: June 22nd-July 9th; Session 2: July 13th-30th. Teachers will verify student attendance daily. Students must also complete first course in order to enroll in second course. This summer school option is for students to meet NCAA requirements.

Students enrolled in "Elective Education Course" classes may attend daily in a summer school designated class and/or work online in alternative settings. Students must stay on pacing guide and finish by July 9th in order to enroll in second course. *MANDATORY* attendance in a summer school designated classroom for all students behind pacing guides.

CREDIT & Credit will be awarded to incoming high school students who successfully complete all required course work and complete course by July 9th and/or July 30th and students cannot have more than three (3) absences in the "Grade Recovery Full Course." Each course meets for 5 hours per day for 60 hours equaling 5 units of credit. A high school student may earn 10 credits by completing Summer School Session 1 and 2. Credit and grades will be sent to the High School Registrar's Office at the end of summer school. Report cards will be mailed home by: August 10th, 2015.

- **DISCIPLINE:** All rules and regulations of the regular school year will apply to summer school/extended school year. Summer school is an OPPORTUNITY! Possession of and/or being under the influence of alcohol or other drugs will result in removal from summer school/extended school year and possible police notification. State Law does not permit tobacco products or their use on school grounds. Appropriate, non-distracting dress is expected. Summer school is a privilege. Students may be dismissed from summer school for inappropriate behavior and incompletion of assignments.
- **ORIENTATION:** Programs will be distributed and summer school requirements will be reviewed on the first day of class on June 22nd, 2015. Incoming 9th-10th grades: 8:00 a.m. Incoming 11th-12th grades: 11:00 a.m. Please be prompt and attentive. Orientation will be at FTK Campus.
