Direct Support Professional Training

Train to work in a residential facility with adults who have intellectual disabilities. *Employment opportunities abound in this field of work*. This class is *Year 1* of a two year training program. It is an intensive three week program with evening and Saturday classes and is specifically designed for students who are currently employed. In a very short period of time, you will be prepared for job opportunities in this important field.

Applicants must demonstrate that they have a high school diploma or a GED.

This program will be offered free of charge.

This course meets the California Department of Developmental Services established requirements for Direct Support Professional training. This competency-based training program is mandatory for all direct support staff working in licensed community care facilities. The Direct Support Professional (DSP) Training is based upon core competencies or skills necessary for satisfactory job performance.
