

Luna Grading Policy

Distance Learning 4th Quarter 2019-2020

SLUSD and SLTA (the teacher's union) have come to an agreement on how students will be graded starting April 13th until the end of the 2019-2020 school year. The agreement for middle-school students is:

- *Students will receive a **Pass/Incomplete** grade for the 4th quarter*
- *If incomplete work is not made up within 6 weeks of school reopening, the **Incomplete** shall become a **No Pass**.*

Along these lines, with respect to how Mr. Luna's class is normally graded, the following will be the grading policy for Distance Learning during the 4th quarter of 2019-2020.

Activity	Description & options	Percentage of grade	Timeframe
Class Participation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Attend at least one online classwork session. <p>OR</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Watch the recorded videos made by Mr. Luna and send him at least one email with questions or requests for clarification. 	50%	Per week for everything.
Evidence of work	<p>Complete any 2 pages of work that Mr. Luna has provided. This can be in the problem set, exit ticket or homework.</p> <p>Turn in by attaching the completed Microsoft Word or .pdf document to an email or to Google Classroom.</p>	10% for showing your work + 30% for getting the answers right = 40% total	Work will be posted and online sessions will happen each week, however, there are no deadlines or due dates. Get it in when you can.
Demonstrate understanding of skills	On completed work, show that you understand how to do it by doing problems correctly.
