- Hanging the kindness chain in the hallway.

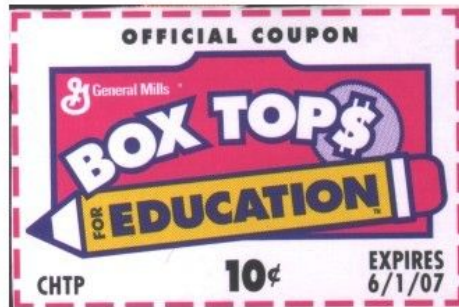

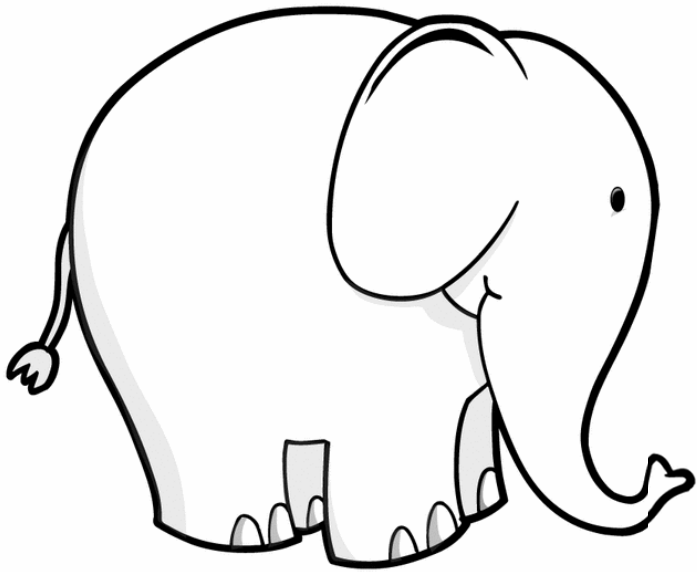
