Please check in with your students teacher regarding time for guests to arrive that day.

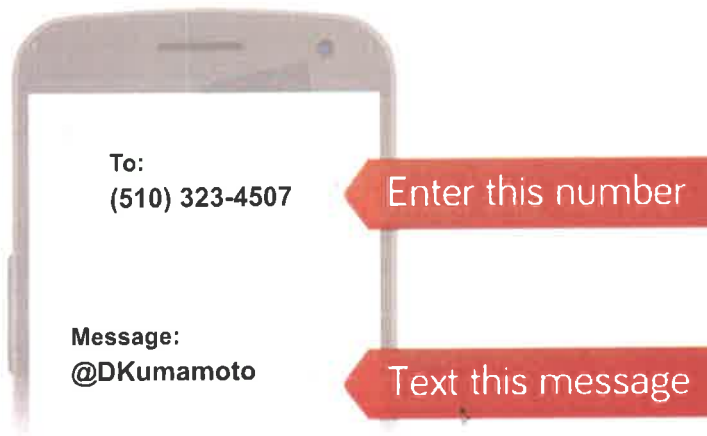
