Opening Activity: Island survival icebreaker game

Approval of August Meeting Minutes: Jenny advised that the August minutes were sent out via email to members. Called for a motion to approve. Gigi made a motion to approve the minutes with the following correction: Gigi Moore, Parliamentarian, presented the bylaw updates to the membership, not Jenny Larsen as written. Motion was seconded (I missed who seconded this item, to be added), and a vote was held that approved.

Teachers Report: Debbie Dodd gave the teacher's report. Community on the green had a good turn out, the planning committee cut back on entertainment this year, and the Aztec dancers who performed at past events did not participate as Mrs. Valdivia who was the contact person is no longer at Roosevelt. Mrs. Dodd is looking for feedback on the event to be taken into consideration in planning next year.

-10/5 will be no school, teachers have professional development for ELD curriculum incorporating tech

-Oct 8th-12 (tk-3rd) and Oct 8th-16th (4th-5th) will be parent teacher conferences, extra early dismissal 12:50 for grades 1-5. Parents are encouraged to come with questions and concerns.

-Teachers are beginning to use DreamBox, a new computer program for math. It is more adaptive and adjusts to the student's level.

-Roosevelt has 6 new teachers this year. The whole staff is excited about PBIS and Toolbox.

-Volunteer packets are trickling in, many are missing portions including driver's info. Many classes are low on approved drivers, this may make field trips challenging. Mrs. Dodd noted that some insurance companies may allow drivers to increase insurance levels just for the one day to make having sufficient coverage affordable.

Guest Speaker: Christian Rodriguez spoke about Measure I, an important item on the November ballot. This needs parent support, vital for programming at our schools. Measure I continues the existing tax, not a new tax. Volunteers are needed for campaign, encouraged to like measure I on Facebook.

Treasurers Report: Kristina Keller opened the floor to follow up questions raised at the previous meeting. The appearance that PTA is operating at a significant loss is because our expenses are inflated, and our income is conservative (showing worst case scenario). Over the past few years our budgets have always been set up in this way although our actual spending has always been well under our income. It is possible to re-evaluate this method, and to look deeper into what a more realistic expense is per line item.

Monthly spending in August- auction reimbursements, teacher wish list items, field trip payments

Ratify checks- Lisa Mussellman made a motion to ratify checks through #5219, Jaime Barbieri seconded, motion was voted on and approved

Programs and Assemblies: report given by Jessica Seibert and Sadie Alvarado. Focus is on programs that support academics this year. Taking a break from Kid Power.

-10/22 hosting the California Math Festival. They will have hands on math activities, make math fun and engaging, day event for all students plus an evening portion for families to attend. Volunteers are needed for morning, afternoon, and evening shifts

-Rock the block safety assembly coming soon

-1/14 Creative writing assembly, this was recommended by Ms. Weidener. Students bring stories written in class to act out

-Possible parent night to learn strategies to support reading, writing, homework, use of tech, safety. Looking for more ideas, please share any that you have with programs

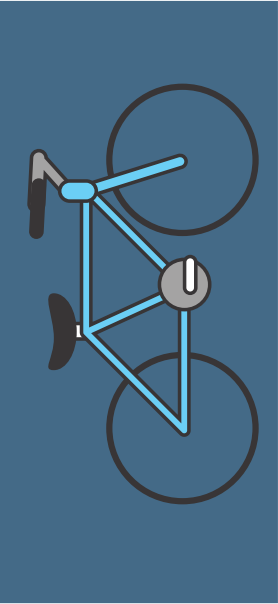

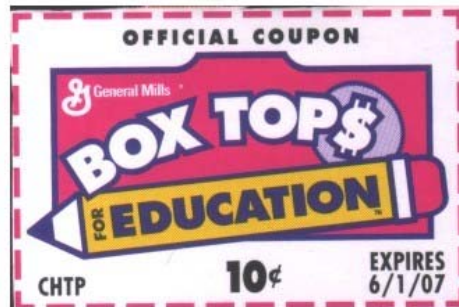
