# Green Hornet StopWaste Challenge!

Ms. Weidner's Waste-ologists Investigation Results Are In...

Partnering with StopWaste's 4Rs Student Action Project, a project-based learning program, all 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Classes will be transforming into Garbologists, scientists who study garbage and our human impact on earth's ecosystems and take action at home, at school and in their community. Ms. Weidner's class is the first to participate this year. Last week they observed the data StopWaste collected in the cafeteria 3-bin system on the first day of school and decided to take action. They will be the first volunteering to help educate their fellow green hornets to sort in the right bin at lunch time. Below are the results of how we sorted our lunch. Do you agree that we need to take action, like Ms. Weidner's class:

## LANDFILL

10% was landfill items 90% compostables and recyclables.

The largest item sorted incorrectly: 60% was wasted food.

## COMPOSTABLES

92% was compostables 5% recyclables 3% landfill items

The largest item: 56% was wasted food.

## RECYCLABLES

32% recyclables 4% landfill items 64% compostables.

The largest item to be sorted incorrectly: 46% was wasted food

**What do the data results mean?** Ms. Weidner's garbologists, or Waste-ologists, as they like to call themselves, believe it means that we can do better and we must take action! That is why they will be challenging the entire school to take the Green Hornet StopWaste Challenge to reduce the amount of natural resources going to the landfill where they are wasted forever. More to come on the benefits of doing the right thing to stop waste!

**When the earth wins, we win!** Student Volunteers who join the Green Hornet Green Team not only win rewards from the PTA and Parent Green Team (stickers to personalized green hornet aprons to movie tickets) throughout the year, but if Roosevelt makes their goals to have cleaner streams (right thing in right bin) the entire school wins school supplies made of recycled materials!

### In the **Landfill Bin:**

- Juice Pouches



- Spork Packages & Plastic Utensils



- Flimsy Plastic (Ziploc Bags, Candy Wrappers, Chip Bags)

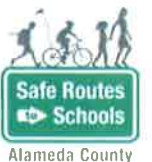

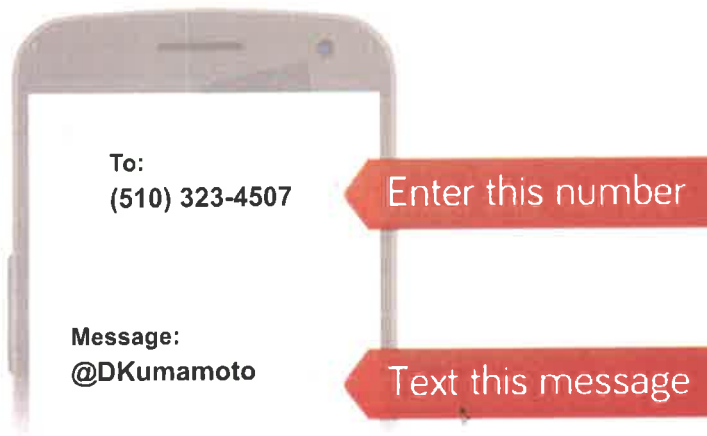
