### Project-Based Learning (PBL)

To prepare our diverse students for today's expanding literacy demands, we adopted **new K-12 standards-aligned curriculum.** Rich informational and literary texts are balanced with integrated language development. Students will develop information, media, visual and computer literacy skills as they work in both digital and traditional environments. Through our new curriculum, our teachers continue to support the academic and linguistic learning needs of all students in SLUSD.

From college-level curriculum and college applications to career planning and pathways, we support students as they develop their long-range goals.


The College Board recognized us as the AP District of the Year, one of three districts out of 13,000 school districts in the nation to win this prestigious honor. We were selected as a national leader in **expanding access** to Advanced Placement courses while simultaneously **improving AP Exam performance.** 

The PSAT and the SAT come free of charge during the school day to **remove any financial barriers** in the college application process. Students can also access customized online test-prep classes through our partnership with Khan Academy.

Our Career Pathways program immerses students in necessary coursework for today's leading industries. After developing a **personalized 10-year plan** in 9th grade, students focus on rigorous college-preparatory curriculum blended with career-specific skill development and work-based learning opportunities.

To better connect families with what's happening in our schools, we have key staff at every site who help all families feel connected to the school community, **in the languages they speak at home.** 

At our enrollment centers, we have prioritized personal assistance in multiple languages. Our home portal also gives families the option to **enroll electronically in three easy steps.**
