Learn ways to help young people learn and use age-appropriate People Safety skills on an everyday basis to have safer, more positive experiences with people, including strangers, siblings, peers, and other people they know.

- **Be and act aware and confident**
- **Check with adults if anything seems unsafe**
- **Move away from possible problems**
- **Follow Stranger Safety rules**

- **Use voice as a safety tool**
- **Set clear boundaries**
- **Say “No” or “Stop” clearly and respectfully**
- **Deal with other kids poking, pushing, grabbing, etc.**
- **Use safety plans if lost in a store, park, or library**
- **Get help from busy adults - and persist!**

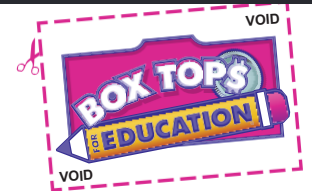
