Principal's Report –

- Thank you to Dad's Club for garden clean up day. Soraya discussed with Dad's club using garden planters by K classes.
- 6 English learners will be reclassified this year. Our reclassification rate is 14%, the third highest in the district. Our EL population is relatively small.

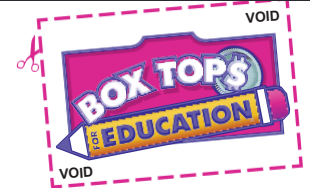
