Principal/Teacher's Report

- Thank you for purchasing 3 ELMO's.
- Math academy – in the 3rd week and running smoothly.
- Hornet Hustle – December 16 it will be coming back with some reorganization
- Conflict Managers – started this week.
- Camp Arroyo – last Thursday. Took about 80 kids to camp in Livermore. Walkathon Fundraising fully covered the cost of the trip. Gearing up for 5th grade outdoor Ed in January.
- Special Person's Day – tomorrow, Nov. 20.
- Common Core Parents Workshops – December 10 is math at Jefferson Elementary.
- No School next week
- December 7 – Parent teacher conferences start. 12:50 dismissal. TK and K get out at 11:40 (all on early schedule). Report cards will go out at conferences.
- December 2 – Coffee and Conversation 8:10
- December 4 – Winter Reading Program Begins
- December 9 – all school assembly

Programs

- KidPower – Parent child workshop with a cap of 30 children with 1-2 parents each. Normally costs \$850 but we got a full grant so free. Also two 2hr. workshops for 5th grade. Got a \$500 grant so our responsibility is \$1200. Will have a parent only night hopefully in March open to all schools with a \$5 donation.
- Bucket filling – date TBD
- Jaime will send out survey about todays circus assembly.
- Has not heard back from Girls Inc.

Fundraising

- Gift wrap – made just over \$7000, which was more than budgeted. The 4th grade and 5th grade portion will be credited to Outdoor Ed. (\$450)
- Walkathon – raised over \$17,000. Camp Arroyo was around \$5800.
- Exploring New Horizons – just over \$16,000. Will not have enough funds from what was raised so we will need to ask for more.
- Fall Festival – need to pay Dads Club and Custodial fee. Tricia anticipates that we will have raised over \$3000.
- **ESCRIP – Safeway is no longer participating. Since it was our largest contributor, we will most likely not make what we anticipated.**

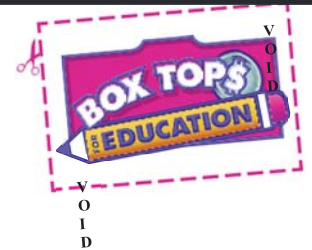
