Required Documents:

Please be sure to bring the following supporting documents with you to the Centralized Enrollment Center on your appointment day to finalize your student's enrollment:

Proof of Residency:

- Parent/legal guardian** Identification (driver's license or passport)
- Proof of Residence** includes: **Two (2) current bills** (phone, Cable TV, PG&E, EBMUD, Garbage, Bank, Statement, Medical or Government correspondence (dated and posted within 30 days). **One (1) original:** Property Tax Bill, Mortgage Verification, Deed of Trust, Close of Escrow or Rental Agreement
- Shared Residency Contract:** If you are sharing residence with another family, the proof of residence will be in that person's name and in addition we require 2 pieces of mail in parent's name. A 30 day provisional enrollment will be granted if you just moved and have not received mail in your name (Home Visit Required)

Health History Documentation:

- Immunization Records** [for the following immunizations: Polio, DTP, Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR), Varicella (Chicken Pox), and Hepatitis B] **Your child will NOT be able to start school until you have provided documentation of ALL required immunizations.** See other side for details.
- Physical Exam required for entering 1st grade (valid exams up to 18 months prior to entry)
- Dental Examination Record (1st year in public school examination required for all students)

Required Student Information:

- Birth Certificate or Passport
- Report Card/ Transcript from previous school attended (does not apply to new TK or Kindergarten students)
- Test Score Summary from previous school attended
- Current IEP (if applicable)
- Current 504 plan (if applicable)
- Custody/Divorce court documents (if applicable)
- Court/Restraining Order (if applicable)
- Foster Youth Parent Agreement (if applicable)

- Contrato Para Domicilio Compartida:** Si usted comparte domicilio con otra familia, el comprobante de domicilio debe estar a nombre de dicha persona, además se requiere dos facturas a nombre del padre del estudiante que comparte domicilio. Otorgaremos matrícula condicional de 30 días, a todas aquellas personas que se hayan mudado y no tengan aún correspondencia a su nombre, se requiere visita domiciliaria.

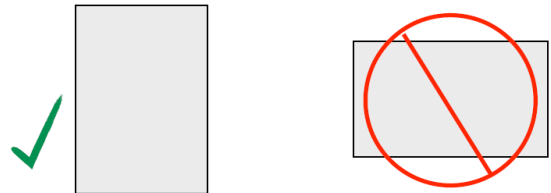

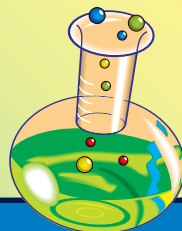
