NEW INTRA-DISTRICT OPEN ENROLLMENT BEGINS February 28, 2017

Between Feb. 28-May 12th	Parents submit Intent to Return forms, and School Choice requests to Office Manager at school sites. Sites submit new Intra-district request forms and School Choice applications to Student Services office.
By June 30th	District approves or denies new requests & notifies parents/legal guardians by mail. <i>(If the number exceeds the space available, the District will hold a lottery on June 9, 2017. Participants will be notified by mail).</i>

NEW INTRA-DISTRICT TRANSFERS: *PRIORITY ORDER*

Priority Transfers will be considered according to the following order:

1. Space availability at the site requested
2. TK-8 siblings of special education students whose IEP has placed them at a specific school
3. TK-8 siblings of continuing students on an approved Intra district Transfer
4. Students whose parent/legal guardian is assigned to that school as his/her primary place of employment
5. Lottery number selected (if needed)
- 6.

Note: The District cannot exceed class size limits. Therefore, to balance classes it is likely that some students will be moved to another school which may impact the placement of students on an Intra-district permit and those with lottery numbers.

NEW & CONTINUING INTER-DISTRICT TRANSFERS & EE to K and TK

March 6th through May 12th	Student Services will begin accepting New Inter-district transfer requests/applications.
IMPORTANT	PLACEMENT IS BASED ON SPACE AVAILABILITY.
IMPORTANT	Continuing students on an Inter-district permit may remain enrolled in their school, <i>unless</i> the student is displaced by a student who resides in the school attendance area, or if the student fails to meet the established criteria . You will be notified on or before June 9th, 2017 if the permit is not going to be renewed.
IMPORTANT	A new Inter-district is only required for students transitioning to 6 th or 9 th grade. Students who fail to submit an application as required will lose their placement for the coming year.
Early Entrance to TK and K March 6th through May 12th	Student Services will begin accepting applications for Early admission to TK and K for the 2017-2018 school year . TK Regular Eligibility: Born between September 2, 2012 to December 2, 2012 TK Early Entrance Application Eligibility: Born between December 3, 2012 to February 28, 2013 K Regular Eligibility: Born On or before September 1, 2012 K Early Entrance Application Eligibility: Born Between September 2, to October 31, 2012 Applying for Early Entrance does not guarantee acceptance. There is an application process that involves testing. Admittance into Early Entrance does not guarantee space in a classroom as age-eligible resident students are placed first.

We have a Spanish Bilingual Literacy Pathway Transitional Kindergarten at Jefferson Elementary.

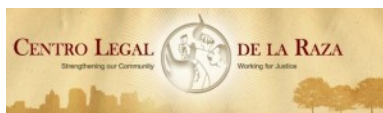

- ☐ List of your addresses and employment and/or schools for the past 5 years, including start and end dates. **See other side →**
- ☐ List of **all** your trips out of the U.S. including departure and return dates. **See other side →**
- ☐ If you are currently married: spouse's full legal name, date of birth, green card A#, date and place of naturalization, and current address
- ☐ Information about all your prior marriages and about all of your current spouse's prior marriages, including date of marriage, date the marriage ended, and how marriage ended.
- ☐ If you have children: their full name, dates of birth, green card A#, and address. **See other side →**

- ☐ *Fee Waiver: *Bring documents proving that your household income is low, like pay stubs, income taxes and/or proof that you or a relevant household member receive public benefits like SSI, IHSS, Medi-Cal, food stamps/ CalFresh, WIC, CalWorks, Cash Assistance, etc.*

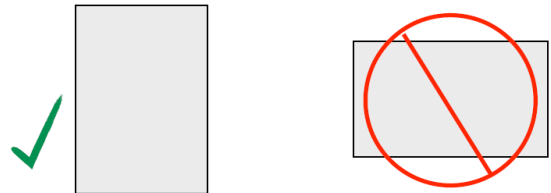
