NEXT WEEK IS “RESPECT AND KINDNESS WEEK” AT ROOSEVELT!

Greetings Roosevelt families!

Next week, Jan. 16-20, Roosevelt will be joining in the national observance of “No-Name Calling Week.” Here at Roosevelt we are dubbing it “Respect and Kindness Week”! Our school is committed to building an environment where everyone feels safe and welcome, and where bullying is not tolerated.

We recognize the impact that hurtful words can have on our students. A recent survey of students aged 9 to 13 showed they consider name-calling to be the worst kind of verbal bullying, and that threatening words or taunting based on race or appearance have as much negative impact as does physical bullying. Respect and Kindness Week is one way we can respond to this problem.

This year’s National No Name Calling Week starts on Martin Luther King Jr. Day and ends on Inauguration Day. At this time it is more important than ever to lead our students in building empathy and expressing respect for each other. Your child’s teacher will be offering lessons and activities on these themes during the week (and beyond). Here are some ways you can support the effort:

- Ask your child what they are learning about words and their impact during Respect and Kindness Week.
- Ask your child if they know anyone who has been called hurtful names at school, and help them brainstorm what they can do to be an ally to that child.
- Consider reviewing your own behavior and language at home. Do you use negative terms for people who are different from you, or overlook it in others? Can you find ways to model more empathy and kindness at home?
- Reach out to your child’s teacher with any ideas or concerns.

¡LA SEMANA SIGUIENTE ES "SEMANA DEL RESPETO Y DE LA AMABILIDAD" EN ROOSEVELT!

Saludos familias de Roosevelt!

La semana que viene, del 16 al 20 de enero, Roosevelt se unirá a la observancia nacional de "No-Name Calling Week". ¡Aquí en Roosevelt lo estamos doblando "Semana de Respeto y Amabilidad"! Nuestra escuela está comprometida a construir un ambiente donde todos se sientan seguros y bienvenidos, y donde el acoso no sea tolerado.

Reconocemos el impacto que las palabras dañinas pueden tener en nuestros estudiantes. Una encuesta reciente de estudiantes de entre 9 y 13 años mostró que consideran que llamar a los nombres es el peor tipo de intimidación verbal, y que las palabras amenazadoras o burlas basadas en la raza o apariencia tienen tanto impacto negativo como la intimidación física.

La Semana Nacional de Respeto de este año comienza el Día de Martin Luther King Jr. y termina el Día de la Inauguración. En este momento es más importante que nunca guiar a nuestros estudiantes a construir empatía y expresar respeto mutuo. El maestro de su hijo (a) ofrecerá clases y actividades sobre estos temas durante la semana (y más allá). Aquí hay algunas maneras en que puede apoyar el esfuerzo:

- Pregúntele a su hijo lo que están aprendiendo acerca de las palabras y su impacto durante la Semana de Respeto
- Pregúntele a su hijo si conoce a alguien a quien se le ha llamado nombres dañinos en la escuela y ayúdelo pensar sobre lo que puede hacer para ser un aliado para ese niño.
- Considere revisar su propio comportamiento e idioma en casa. ¿Usas términos negativos para personas que son diferentes de ti? ¿Puedes encontrar maneras de modelar más empatía y bondad en casa?
- Póngase en contacto con el maestro de su hijo con cualquier idea o preocupación.

ATTENDANCE

If your child/children are going to be absent please make sure the front Office or teacher gets a note &/or a phone call to excuse your child/children within **48 hours of the absence.**

- **Excused** absences are Doctor/Dentist, illness or funeral (immediate family). There will be no excuse for vacations or days out of town (unless you are gone for more than **5** days and complete an Independent Study Contract).
- **UNVERIFIED** is if you don't excuse your child within 48 hours for their illness. Please make sure the teacher or front office has received your excuse. ***We cannot change unverified to excused after 48 hours.***
- **TARDY** is any time after the bell. Tardy bells are 8:10 & 9:30 (K's only). **THERE ARE NO EXCUSES FOR TARDIES AND THEY CANNOT BE ERASED.**
After 5 tardies you will receive a warning letter regarding your child's attendance.
- **VERY LATE** is 30 minutes or more and these also cannot be erased.
- **INDEPENDENT STUDY CONTRACT (5 days or more)**
Contracts can be picked up in the front Office. Please give your teacher(s) at least **one week** to prepare work for your child.

ASISTENCIA

Si su hijo(s) van a estar ausentes favor de asegurarse que la oficina principal o el maestro de su hijo(s) reciban una nota y/o una llamada por teléfono para excusar a su hijo(s) no menos de **48 horas de la ausencia.**

- **FALTAS JUSTIFICADAS** son AUSENCIAS POR Doctor/Dentist, ENFERMEDAD, FUNERAL (Familia inmediata). No habrá excusa por vacaciones o días por salida fuera de la ciudad (al menos que usted se vaya por mas de **5** días y complete un Contrato de Estudios Independientes).
- **SIN VERIFICAR** es si usted no excusa a su hijo(s) al menos dentro de 48 horas por enfermedad. Por favor asegúrese de que el maestro o la oficina principal han recibido su excusa. ***No podemos cambiar sin verificar la excusa después de 48 horas.***
- **LLEGAR TARDE** es cualquier hora después de la Segunda campanada es considerado retardo. La campana de retardo suena a las 8:10 y 9:30 (solamente K's). **NO HAY EXCUSA PARA RETARDOS Y NO PODRÁN SER BORRADOS.**
Quando tenia mas de cinco (5) días que llegar tarde va a tener una nota.
- **MUY TARDE** son 30 minutos y más y esta tampoco podrá ser borrada.
- **CONTRACTO DE ESTUDIOS INDEPENDIENTES (5 días o más)** Los contratos pueden ser pedidos en la oficina principal. Favor de darle el contrato a el/la maestro(a) de su hijo(a) al menos con **una semana** antes para permitir prepararles el trabajo para su hijo(a).
