Last day to submit photos is March 1. Someone is doing 5<sup>th</sup> grade baby pictures. Mayela will send out a blast to inform parents.

### Fundraising –

- Ongoing are Schoola and gift wrap.

### Audit –

- January 2015-June 2015. Went well. Maria made a motion to approve the audit, Nicole seconded. Approved.
- Taxes – are complete and Tricia will file this week.

## PTA BOARD 2015-2016

### Principal/Teacher's Report

- Math academy will start again in February. Fall session was about \$1100 for 40 students for 5 weeks.
- Outdoor education – students are at Pigeon Point. Made a deposit of over \$14,000 in December. Final invoice will come later for a total cost of about \$20,000. Should be in good shape. Just got a donation today from SLED for \$1,000. It can go towards boat trip as well. (about \$3,000 last year)
- Testing is happening right now. A parent report will be coming out soon.
- Fences are going up. Should take about 4 weeks. Concern that new fence on Dutton side will be much shorter than current fence.
- Library is now open after school from 3:30-5 for second to fifth graders. There will be a sign up for each day. There is a link on the school website.
- School Smarts academy – parent workshops on Monday nights starting February 1 for 7 weeks.
- ACE clubs are at full capacity. District pays for about 60% of costs.
- Next Tuesday Roosevelt will highlight project based learning at the board meeting.
- AAPAG turned in \$122 from an auction bowling night.

### Board Elections

- Will happen March 17. All positions are open and we are looking for volunteers. Positions and duties will go out in newsletter.

### Treasurer's Report

- Reviewed November and December balance sheets. We raised most of the money to cover outdoor ed. And wrote a check for \$14,400 to pay for deposit. Ending balance for outdoor education is just under \$3,000 and more money is coming in. SLED is putting in \$1,000 and LCAP is putting in \$5,000. Gift wrap raised about \$7,800, Sees raised about \$1,600. Fall Festival was just over \$3,000.
- Checks 4218-4230 from November needed to be ratified. Maria made a motion to ratify, Heidi seconded. Approved.
- Checks 4231-4242 from December needed to be ratified. Dara made a motion to approved, Nicole seconded. Approved.

### Auction Update

- April 30. Will start in February notifying people. Theme is Mardi Gras. Will have another auction meeting soon. Donation letters have been going out.

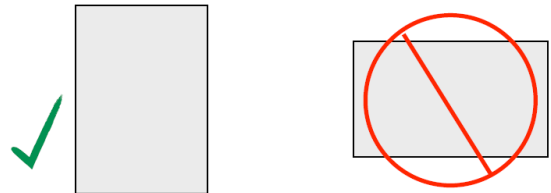

**San Leandro Unified School District**  
**Open Enrollment Policies & Timelines for 2016-2017**  
**Children turning 5 on or before September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2016 are eligible for Kindergarten**  
**Children turning 5 between September 2<sup>nd</sup> and December 2, 2016**  
**are eligible for Transitional Kindergarten**

**NEW INTRA-DISTRICT OPEN ENROLLMENT BEGINS February 22, 2016**

<b>Between Feb. 22-May 13th</b>	Parents submit <b>Intent to Return</b> forms, and <b>School Choice</b> requests to Office Manager at school sites. Sites submit <b>new</b> Intra-district request forms and <b>School Choice</b> applications to Student Services office.
<b>By June 24th</b>	District approves or denies new requests & notifies parents/legal guardians by mail. <i>(If the number exceeds the space available, the District will hold a lottery on June 10, 2016. Participants will be notified by mail).</i>

**NEW INTRA-DISTRICT TRANSFERS: *PRIORITY ORDER***

**Priority Transfers will be considered according to the following order:**

1. Space availability at the site requested
2. K-8 siblings of special education students whose IEP has placed them at a specific school
3. K-8 siblings of continuing students on an approved Intra district Transfer
4. Students whose parent/legal guardian is assigned to that school as his/her primary place of employment
5. Placement of School Choice applicants
6. Lottery number selected (if needed)

**Note: The District cannot exceed class size limits. Therefore, to balance classes it is likely that some students will be moved to another school which may impact the placement of students on an Intra-district permit and those with lottery numbers.**

**NEW & CONTINUING INTER-DISTRICT TRANSFERS & EE to K and TK**

<b>March 7th through May 13th</b>	Student Services will begin accepting New Inter-district transfer requests/applications.
<b>IMPORTANT</b>	Requests stamped received after <b>May 13<sup>th</sup></b> will not be considered until <b>the 10<sup>th</sup> day of (2016-2017) school year</b> . <b>PLACEMENT IS BASED ON SPACE AVAILABILITY.</b>
<b>IMPORTANT</b>	Continuing students on an Inter-district permit may remain enrolled in their school, <i>unless</i> the student is displaced by a student who resides in the school attendance area, or if the student <b>fails to meet the established criteria</b> . You will be notified on or before <b>June 9th, 2016</b> if the permit is not going to be renewed.
<b>IMPORTANT</b>	A <b>new Inter-district</b> is only required for students transitioning to 6 <sup>th</sup> or 9 <sup>th</sup> grade. Students who fail to submit an application as required will lose their placement for the coming year.
<b>Early Entrance to TK and K  March 7th through May 13<sup>th</sup></b>	Student Services will begin accepting applications for Early admission to <b>TK and K for the 2016-2017 school year</b> . TK Regular Eligibility: Born between September 2, 2011 to December 2, 2011 TK Early Entrance Application Eligibility: Born between December 3, 2011 to February 28, 2012 K Regular Eligibility: Born <b>On or before</b> September 1, 2011 K Early Entrance Application Eligibility: Born Between September 2, to October 31, 2011  <b>Applying for Early Entrance does not guarantee acceptance. There is an application process that involves testing. Admittance into Early Entrance does not guarantee space in a classroom as age-eligible resident students are placed first.</b>

We have Transitional Kindergarten at Garfield, McKinley, Monroe, Roosevelt and Wilson Elementary Schools.  
We have a Spanish Bilingual Literacy Pathway Transitional Kindergarten at Jefferson Elementary.

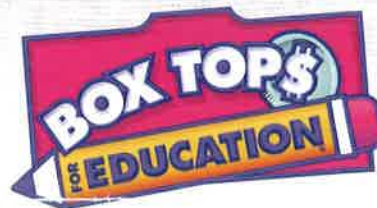
