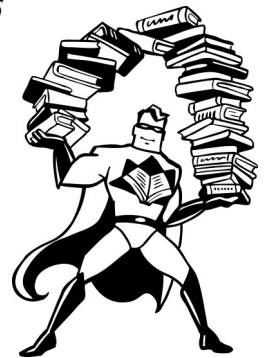


READ-TO-ME! BABY & TODDLER SUMMER READING PROGRAM FOR AGES 0 TO 2

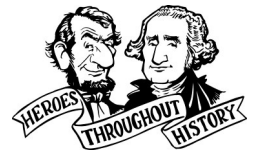

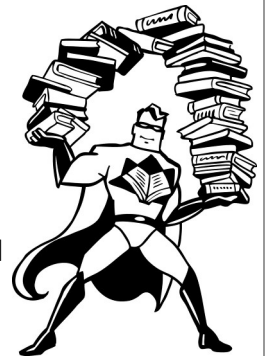
