TK & Kindergarten Registration

If your child will be 5 by September 2nd you will be eligible for Kindergarten. If your child is 4 but will be turning 5 between September 2 and December 2 your child is eligible for the TK program. You may pick up packets for registration starting February 24th. Registration for both TK & K will be held on Wednesday, March 26th. You must have all registration documents (ORIGINALS) in order to register. The required 1st grade physical for Kindergarten must be dated after March 1, 2014. For parents wanting their children to attend Roosevelt you MUST register at their HOME school and apply for an Intra-district Permit. If you have any question please contact the front office at 618-4350.

Enrollment for NEW incoming students Grades 1-5 will begin on May 1st.

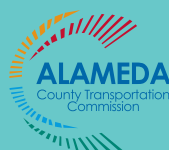

- **Be and act aware and confident**
- **Check with adults if anything seems unsafe**
- **Move away from possible problems**
- **Follow Stranger Safety rules**

- **Set clear boundaries**
- **Say “No” or “Stop” clearly and respectfully**
- **Deal with other kids poking, pushing, grabbing, etc.**
- **Use safety plans if lost in a store, park, or library**
- **Get help from busy adults - and persist!**

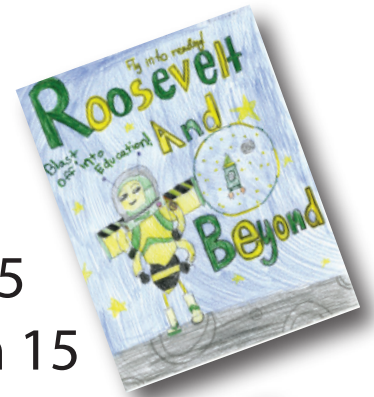

AFFORDABLE HEALTH COVERAGE JUST GOT EASIER!

- ▶ Financial assistance will be available for many families and individuals, students, parents, and employees.
- ▶ No one can be denied coverage because of a pre-existing health condition, such as asthma or diabetes.
- ▶ Several plans and cost choices will be available.

Affordable Health Coverage Means

- ▶ Preventive care for children and adults will be provided at no cost. For example, there will be no co-payments for services like check-ups and immunizations for children or health screenings for adults.
- ▶ Insurers can no longer set annual maximums on care received.

Two Health Care Options for Children and Families:

1 COVERED CALIFORNIA— Affordable Health Insurance

Covered California is the new health insurance marketplace in the state. Four different levels of health insurance plans are available through Covered California. The level determines how much you pay each month, but ALL plans include the same comprehensive benefits.

Financial assistance may be available to help with monthly premium costs. For example, a family of four making between \$32,500 and \$94,200 or a family of two making \$21,400 to \$62,040 a year may be eligible for financial assistance.

2 MEDI-CAL— No or Low-Cost Health Coverage

FOR ADULTS— If, for example, annual income for a family of two is less than \$21,400, adults (including those without children) may be eligible to enroll in Medi-Cal.

FOR CHILDREN— If annual income for a family of four is less than \$58,875, children may qualify for Medi-Cal.

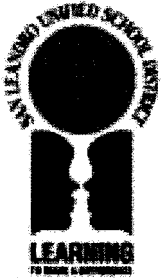

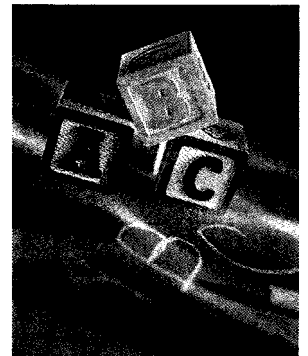
