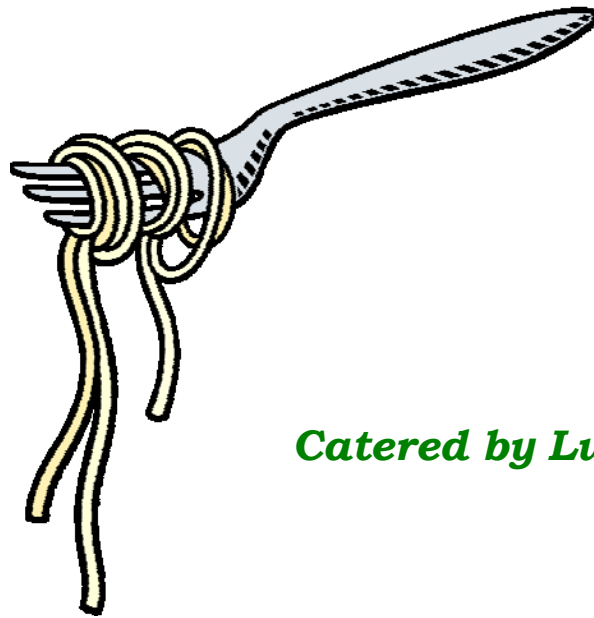

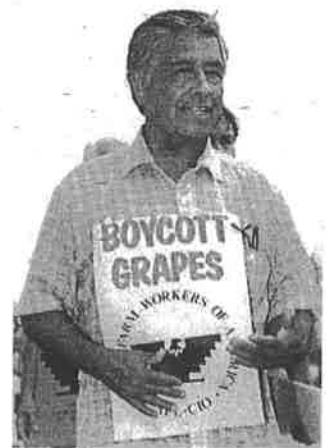

Special activities: Open during Open House

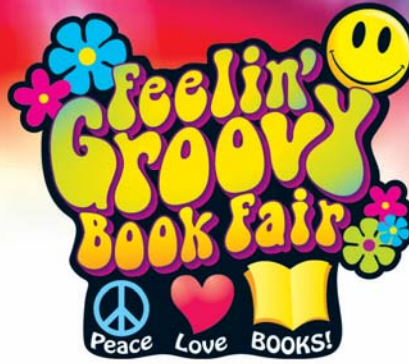

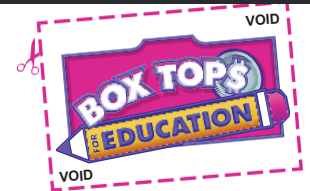
