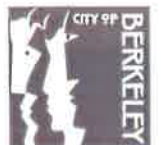

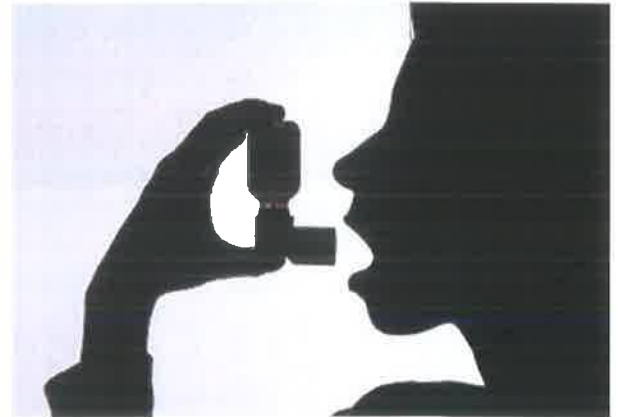




## Asthma Education Workshop for Parents

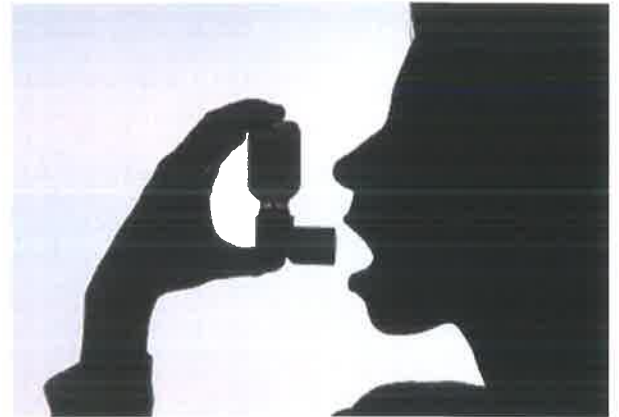
### Who is Breathe California of the Bay Area?

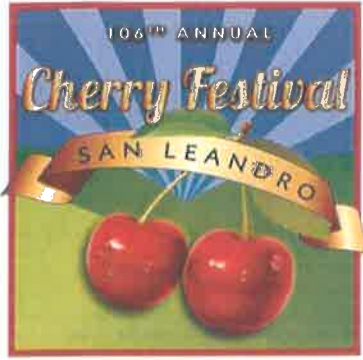
