**We are completely sold out of all youth pull overs and zip hoodies.**

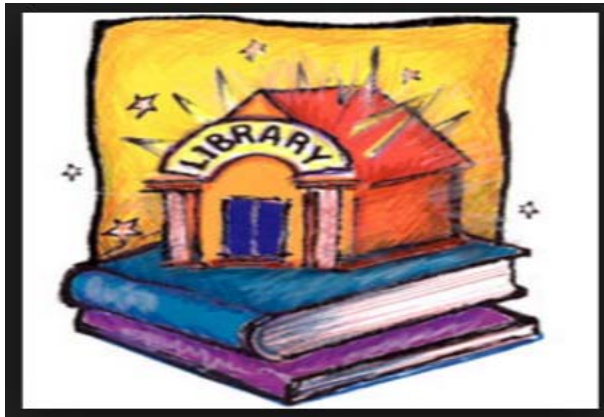

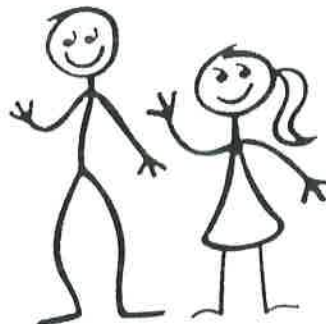
