## Principal's News

Dear Roosevelt Families,

You have likely heard that Roosevelt, along with several other schools in SLUSD and the surrounding area, have been affected by a flea infestation. Here's what we know to date.

In response to parent concerns, the district contracted with a company spray the field with a product called "Essentria IC<sup>3n</sup>". It is a "green" product that is made up of Rosemary Oil and Peppermint Oil. It is safe for the students and families to be on the grass 2 hours following the use of this product.

In addition, we have placed traps inside of some classrooms where we suspect fleas to be present. These traps have proved effective in other San Leandro schools.

Due to the fact that we are experiencing a state-wide drought, and since many of our neighbors regularly bring their animals to our campus after-hours, it is hard to say when this situation will be fully contained. We will continue to monitor and assess the situation. Roosevelt is an open campus with green areas and a garden. From time to time there will be pests in nature and we will do our best to be proactive and reactive when situations arise.

Understandably, some families are still concerned about the safety of the use of the field, particularly because we have two community events that are rapidly approaching: Community on the Green and the Fall Festival. Here is our plan for our upcoming events:

**Community on the Green-** Thursday 10/2/14: We will move the entertainment stage further back on the blacktop to allow families the option of sitting on the grass or the basketball courts. This will allow everyone to enjoy the performances and choose their preferred seating area.

**Fall Festival: Saturday, 10/11/14:** As we get closer to the date of the festival, we will reassess whether there is still a concern about field use. If so, we will configure the layout of booths so it maximizes blacktop use and avoids field areas.

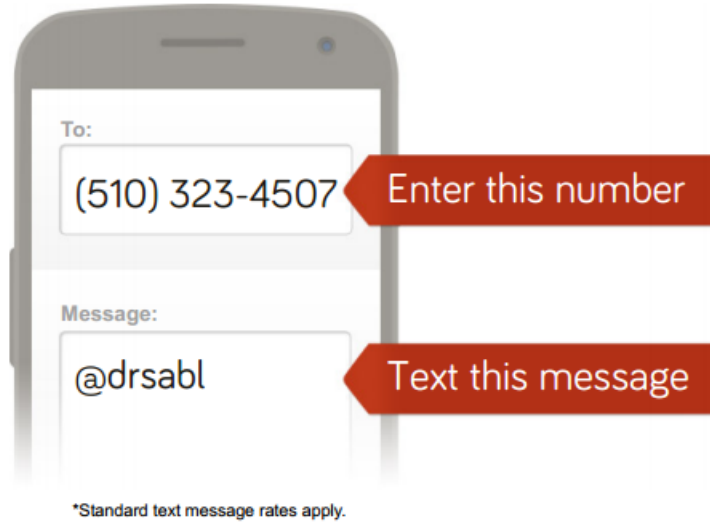

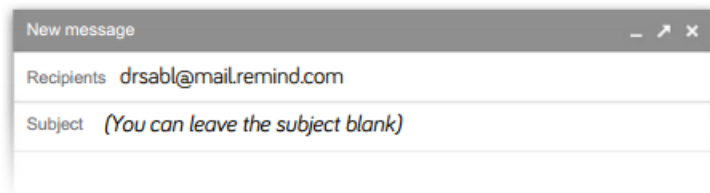
