In consideration of being permitted to participate in any way in College Sports Day on October 26, 2014, hereinafter called "The Activity", I, for myself, my heirs, personal representatives or assigns, **do hereby release, waive discharge, and covenant not to sue** Coaching Corps and/or THE REGENTS OF THE UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA (the "University"), its officers, employees, and agents from liability **from any and all claims including the negligence of Coaching Corps and the University, its officers, employees and agents**, resulting in personal injury, accidents or illnesses (including death), and property loss arising from, but not limited to, participation in The Activity.

**Assumption of Risks:** Participation in The Activity carries with it certain inherent risks that cannot be eliminated regardless of the care taken to avoid injuries. The specific risks vary from one activity to another, but the risks range from 1) minor injuries such as scratches, bruises, and sprains 2) major injuries such as eye injury or loss of sight, joint or back injuries, heart attacks, and concussions to 3) catastrophic injuries including paralysis and death.

**Indemnification and Hold Harmless:** I also agree to INDEMNIFY AND HOLD Coaching Corps and the University HARMLESS from any and all claims, actions, suits, procedures, costs, expenses, damages and liabilities, including attorney's fees brought as a result of my or my child/ward's involvement in The Activity and to reimburse them for any such expenses incurred.

**Severability:** The undersigned further expressly agrees that the foregoing waiver and assumption of risks agreement is intended to be as broad and inclusive as is permitted by the law of the State of California and that if any portion thereof is held invalid, it is agreed that the balance shall, notwithstanding, continue in full legal force and effect.

## Medical Release

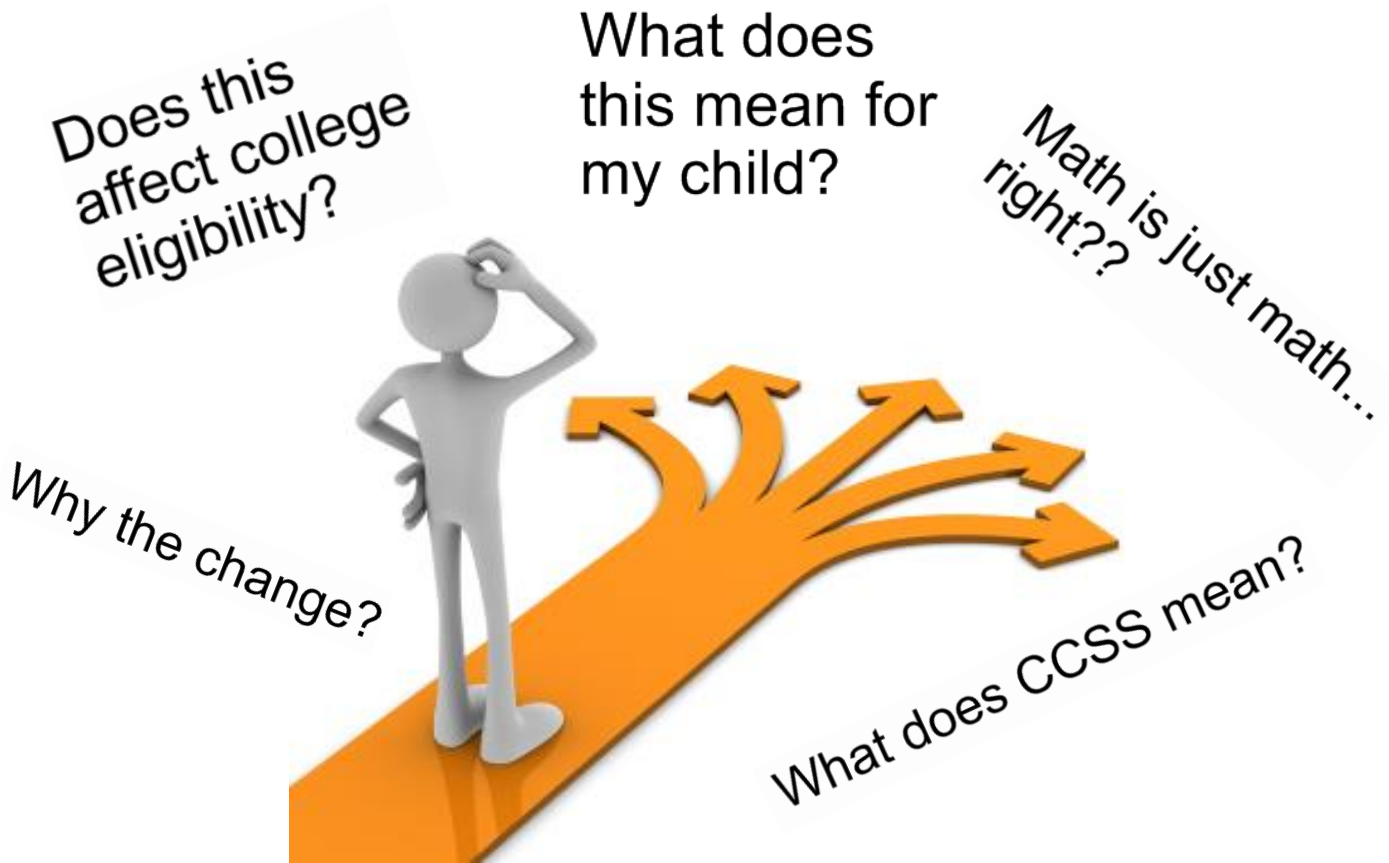
