PTA Meeting – October 20, 2016

Welcome –

Secretary's Report –Minutes from the September 13, 2016 meeting were summarized. Mayela made a motion to approve, Tricia seconded. Approved.

Teacher/Principal Report –

Principal:

- United parent potluck, Community on the Green and Fall Festival were very successful and appreciated.
- Good turn-out for parent ed night about keeping kids safe online.
- Almost at election day. Bond measure on ballot and phone banking is needed. You can go any night and tell them you are from Roosevelt. It is across from the middle school.
- Halloween parade is at 1:00. No scary costumes, no clown costumes.
- Dia de los Muertos display is up. All classes are invited to participate in art projects and any one can bring a photo of a deceased person to display.
- Book Fair did very well – exceeded goal. They will donate \$1000 of rprofit to science lab materials.
- New teacher will start Monday in Room 1 for RSP program.
- District Nutrition Director will come to Coffee and Conversation in November.
- Special Persons Day is November 18. Need a chair for this.

Teacher – Ms. Dodd –

- Teachers are being trained to technology use.
- Teachers are using zearn.org, a web site that is free and goes with eureka math. There is also a web site embark.online that has videos for parents and teachers to understand math concepts and methods.

Programs –

- November 15 Create learning – drawing and motivating. \$895
- March 2 – Ocean Adventure – expedition over frozen tundra \$850
- April – Impossible Show – science and magic. \$800.00

Programs:

- Kidpower – October 11. Kidpower is donating a workshop because we had too many kids in each workshop. Next workshop is October 25. \$1900.00
- CAPS – Free and scheduled for our school.

- Dairy Council – they have too many school and will only come every 3-4 years. We had in January 2015.

Remaining \$1600 of \$3500 budget.

Yearbook – over 50 were sold with discount.

Fence Beautification – around 160 tiles were painted at festival. Will have a night (November 7) for people to paint tiles who did not have a chance. Possibly have a time during lunch for painting and have at Art and Rhythm night. There may also be pull out time to make sure everyone has the opportunity to complete a tile.

Fundraising –

- Gift wrap fundraiser has ended. \$9926 in total sales so will make around \$4,000.
- Schoola drive is happening next week. Stickers and fliers will go home.
- See's – waiting for dates – should go home before Thanksgiving break and due after break.

Festival Report – went great!

Chinook book - Roosevelt is selling these for \$20 and \$10 will go to Roosevelt. Has many local coupons.

Gift cards – Tricia will do this year.

Book Fair – Jill Stowe needs someone to take over and shadow her. It's a big job and needs 2 people.

Board Members and volunteers – we are in need of more volunteers overall at Roosevelt. We asked teachers to think of parents in their room who may participate more if asked. Many board members will be leaving soon and want some continuity. We really need a Treasurer.

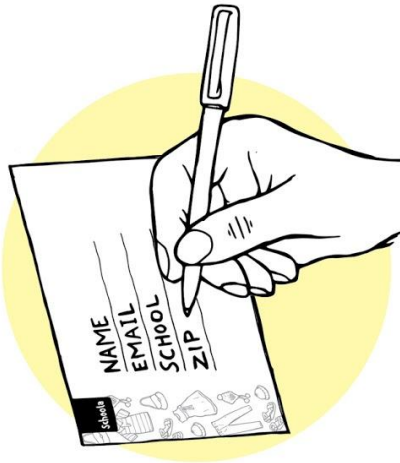

Science Lab Support Teacher 2016-17

Job Description: Roosevelt School is seeking a part-time Science Lab Support Teacher who can design and implement science lab experiences aligned with the Next Generation Science Standards for students in grades TK - 5. This position could be split between two candidates who each focus on upper and lower grade instruction. The ideal candidate will have a love for science and children, be able to effectively manage whole group instruction, lab based science experiments, and collaborate with teachers to ensure continuity between lab experiences and general education science instruction. Credentialed, general education teacher will be present during all science labs.

Desired Qualifications:

- Prior experience with elementary age students
- Ability to develop and adapt lessons for multi-age groups
- Skilled at designing hands-on science experiences
- Strong classroom management skills

Scope of Work

19 classes (TK-5th)

820 minutes per week of instruction

13.6 hrs of instruction per week

Approx. 14 hrs of instruction (rounded up) + 6 hrs of prep per week = 20 hrs per week

25 weeks of instruction (Nov. 2016 - June 2017)

Approximate hourly rate = \$30/hour

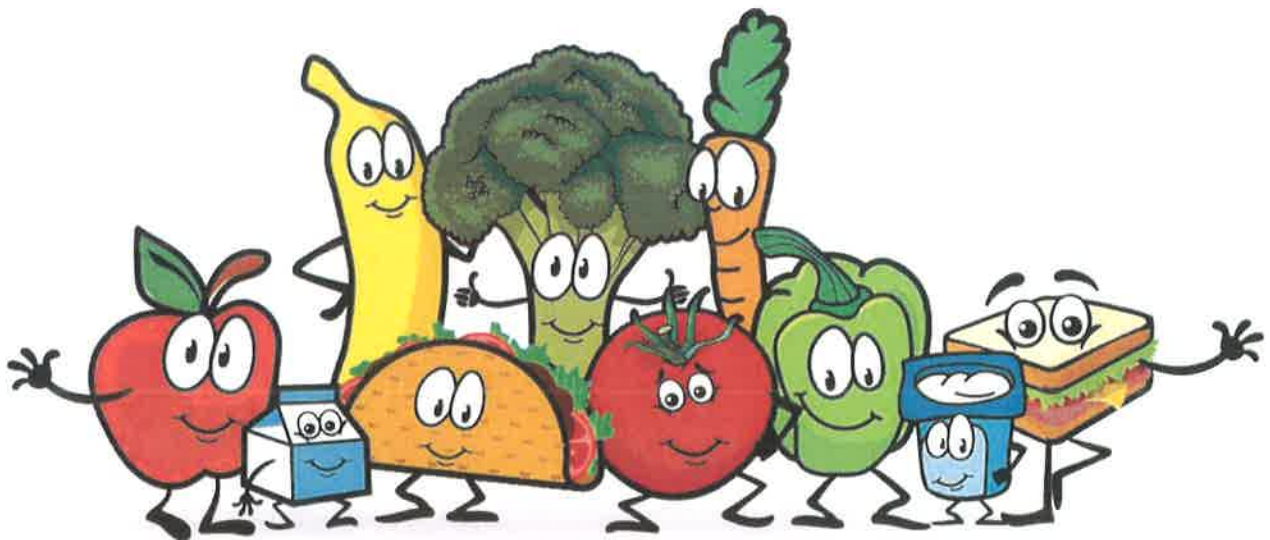

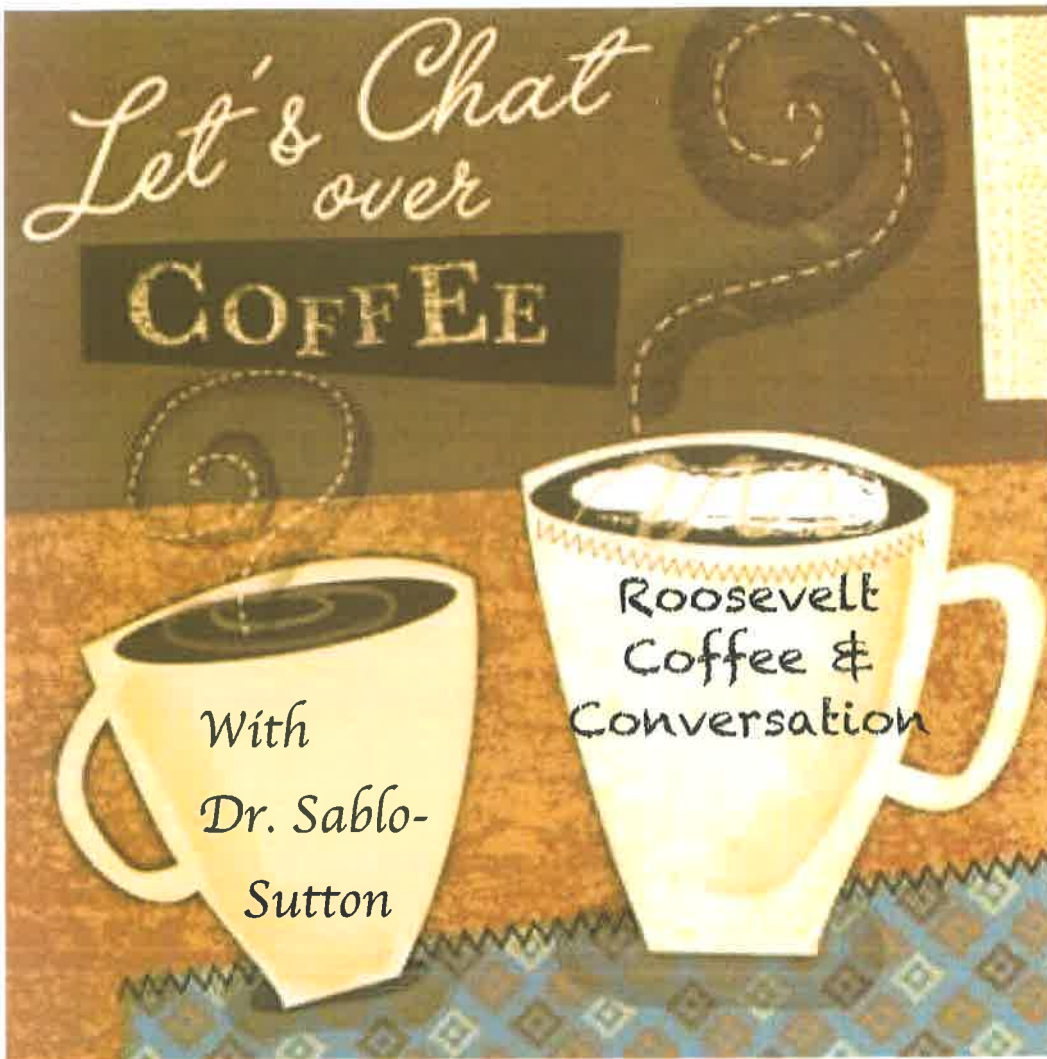

ATTENDANCE

If your child/children are going to be absent please make sure the front Office or teacher gets a note &/or a phone call to excuse your child/children within **48 hours of the absence.**

- **Excused** absences are Doctor/Dentist, illness or funeral (immediate family). There will be no excuse for vacations or days out of town (unless you are gone for more than **5** days and complete an Independent Study Contract).
- **UNVERIFIED** is if you don't excuse your child within 48 hours for their illness. Please make sure the teacher or front office has received your excuse. ***We cannot change unverified to excused after 48 hours.***
- **TARDY** is any time after the bell. Tardy bells are 8:10 & 9:30 (K's only). **THERE ARE NO EXCUSES FOR TARDIES AND THEY CANNOT BE ERASED.**
After 5 tardies you will receive a warning letter regarding your child's attendance.
- **VERY LATE** is 30 minutes or more and these also cannot be erased.
- **INDEPENDENT STUDY CONTRACT (5 days or more)**
Contracts can be picked up in the front Office. Please give your teacher(s) at least **one week** to prepare work for your child.
