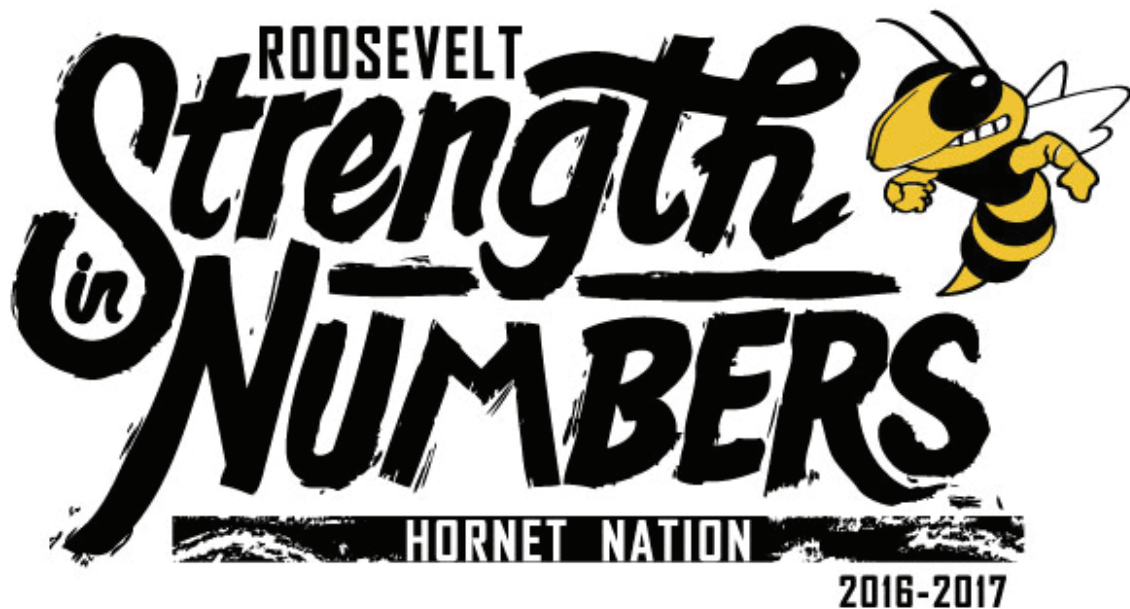

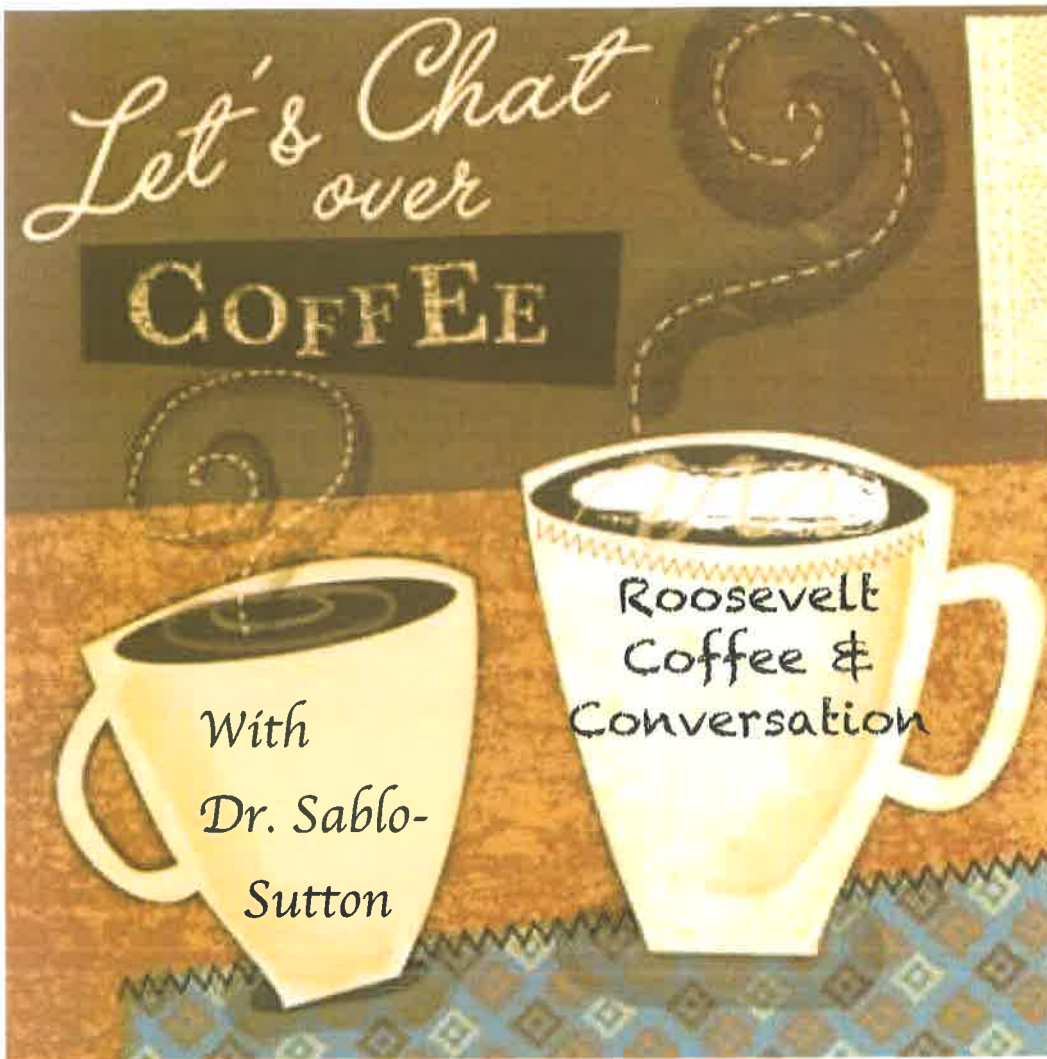

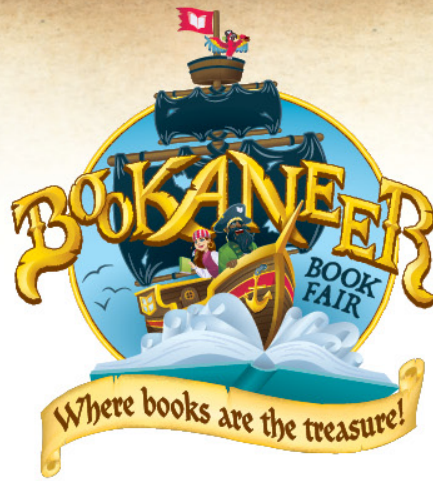

Shopping hours: Everyday After School in our Library

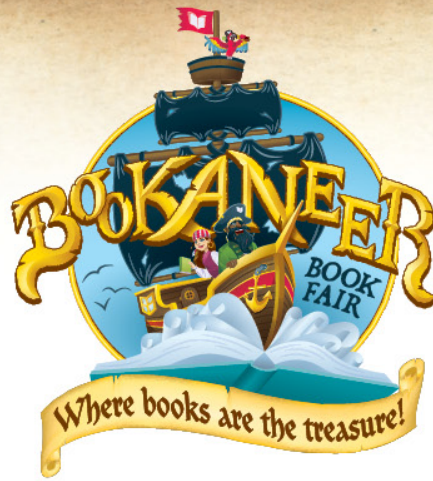
Special activities: Saturday, October 15th – Open All Day at our Fall Festival

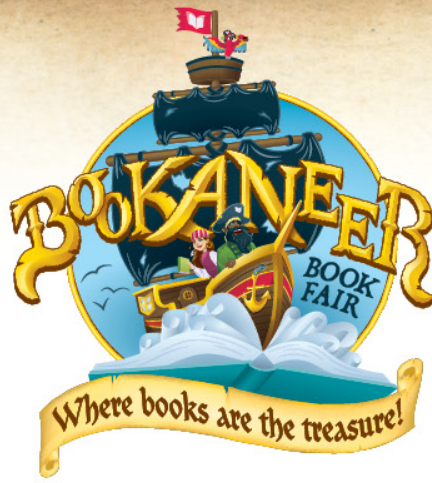
