During the spring 2020 period of school closure in response to the COVID-19 pandemic, the staff of the San Leandro Unified School District (SLUSD) remains committed to supporting the students, staff, and parents/guardians of our school communities.

In response to the school closures, the California Department of Education is allowing districts to request waivers that exempt individual students from the state's minimum graduation requirements. SLUSD will not request a state waiver.

SLUSD governing board has adopted a policy (BP 6146.1) that sets graduation requirements beyond the state's requirements in the Education Code and SLUSD's governing board has the authority to revise that policy and modify those additional requirements.

The following proposal outlined in yellow is the credit reduction recommendation for the Class of 2020:
