Assignment: Create a fashion design that uses 3-dimensional textured paper. Use at least 3 different paper textures by crumpling, twisting, ripping, curling, folding, etc. Look at the last few pages for finished examples.

Step 1: Draw the outline of the figure you want to create. Can be male or female. Keep it Simple because you will glue paper inside the lines. Have a hard time drawing? Google "Croquis" and trace the body template. Or, you can look through a magazine and cut out a figure, then trace the edge on another sheet of paper— we did that on our first assignment this year when we made the mosaic collage with all the small magazine pieces you glued down.

Step 2: Cut out the drawing.




Step 3: Glue it onto Construction Paper if you have some. If you don't, just glue onto any other paper.



Step 4: Last week we experimented with 4 paper textures. Add at least 3 different textures to make your design 3D. Glue the paper textures on and make it fabulous! *Optional:* Add color using colored pencils, sharpie, markers, etc.

Wrap it/Curls Cut Strips and twist Curl tightly Cut Fringes
