How do students enroll?

1. Students must submit an application and talk to their Guidance Counselor to discuss an educational plan that will address their personal and academic needs.
2. Candidates will be contacted by Lincoln's Administration to arrange for an interview and orientation with the student and family.
3. If it is determined that the Lincoln High or Lighthouse is the right placement to meet the needs of the student, they will be invited to enroll onto our campus.

What is Lincoln Alternative Education Center all about?

As a District on the move, LAEC (Lincoln Alternative Education Center) offers a variety of responsive, personalized educational pathways for career and college readiness. Through the use of student centered learning, the pathways we seek to create serve as both a trajectory, and a bridge, to ensure our students' success in the 21st Century. Through this model our site offers two programs: Lincoln (Continuation) High School and Lighthouse Independent Studies, which allow our scholars to meet their graduation requirements, academic goals, and socio-emotional needs.

The Alternative Programs (Lincoln and Lighthouse)

are designed to accommodate the individual learning styles,
academic requirements and social needs of all students.

Lincoln Continuation High School

is a credit recovery high school designed for students 16 or older who are committed to recovering their credits, and reconnecting to their academics goals. Our scholars take advantage of the ways in which credits are earned to receive their diploma with their graduating class.

Lighthouse Independent Study

gives students who learn well on their own a way to complete their studies when health, family, or work obligations interfere with daily schooling. The Independent Studies program grants flexibility in student scheduling and support, without the loss of rigor.
