#### **Principal's Message:**

As we get into the thick of the school year **Attendance Counts! The first step is** 

starting the day on time.

So much of learning and student success depends on being at school on time and ready to learn. Students who arrive late and leave early miss important aspects of each lesson.

# Starting the day

Frontloading key vocabulary, connecting concepts to the real world, organizing the students and clarifying expectations are all components that teachers use to set up successful learning for the day. When students arrive late they miss key elements of the lesson plans and they can struggle throughout the rest of the day.

# **Ending the day**

When students are picked up early they miss the validation of their hard work. The teachers often review homework and reconnect it to the days learning. Teachers look back over the day to see how much students retain and what they have learned so that they can adjust the next day's lessons to meet the needs of all children.

# Missing the day

Life does not stop or hold still for school. We know that children get sick, have appointments, and family emergencies. Unfortunately, the State of California only funds the students who attend each day! When a student misses the entire day, funding is lost. This hurts everyone, salaries, programs, and services. The State does provide funding for partial days. If you must schedule an appointment having your child here some of the day counts. Remember three unexcused or unverified absences will trigger an Irregular attendance letter.

#### **Health and Wellness focus**

Both the District and James Madison are prioritizing health and wellness. As a part of the Wellness Policy we are encouraging all families who wish to celebrate their child's birthday to think of a healthy treat. We have many students with food allergies and we want to promote a healthy lifestyle. We ask you not bring in cupcakes or other sweet treats.
