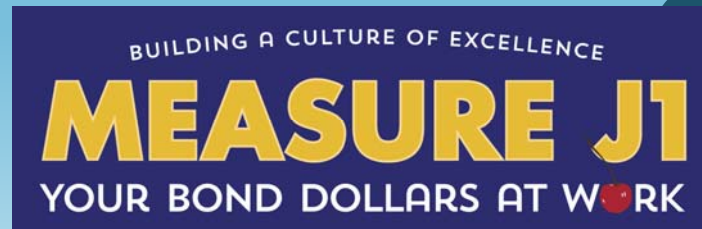

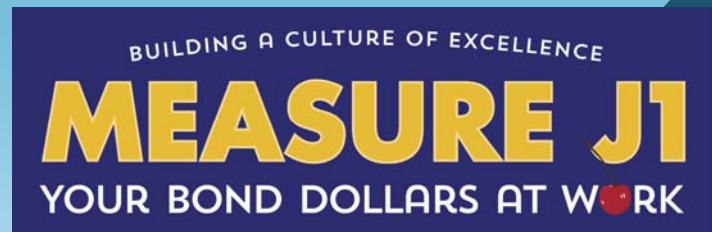

CBOC Mission:

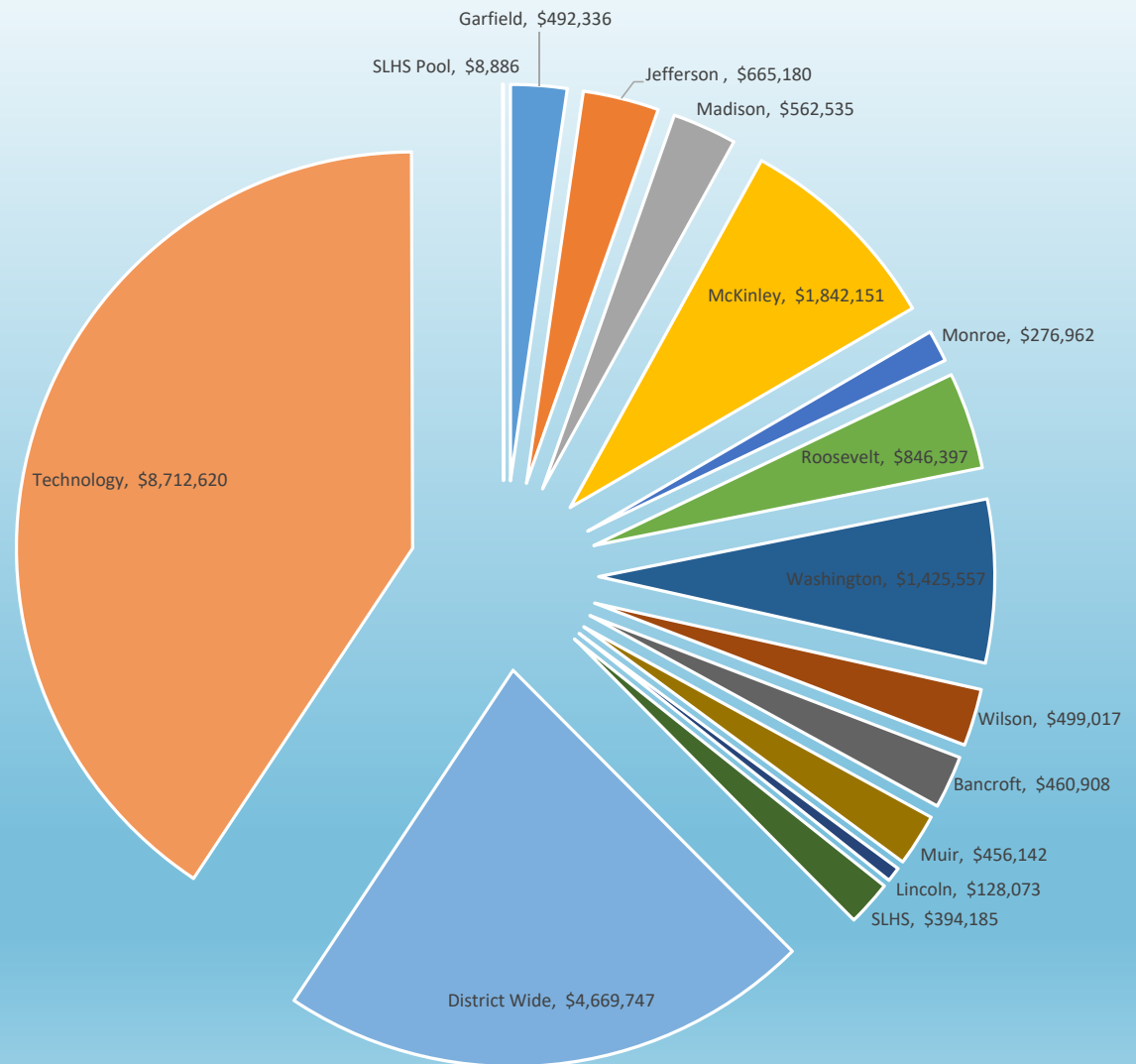
- Inform the citizens of San Leandro regarding the expenditure of General Obligation Bond revenues

Expenditures and Encumbrances By SITE (through May 2018)

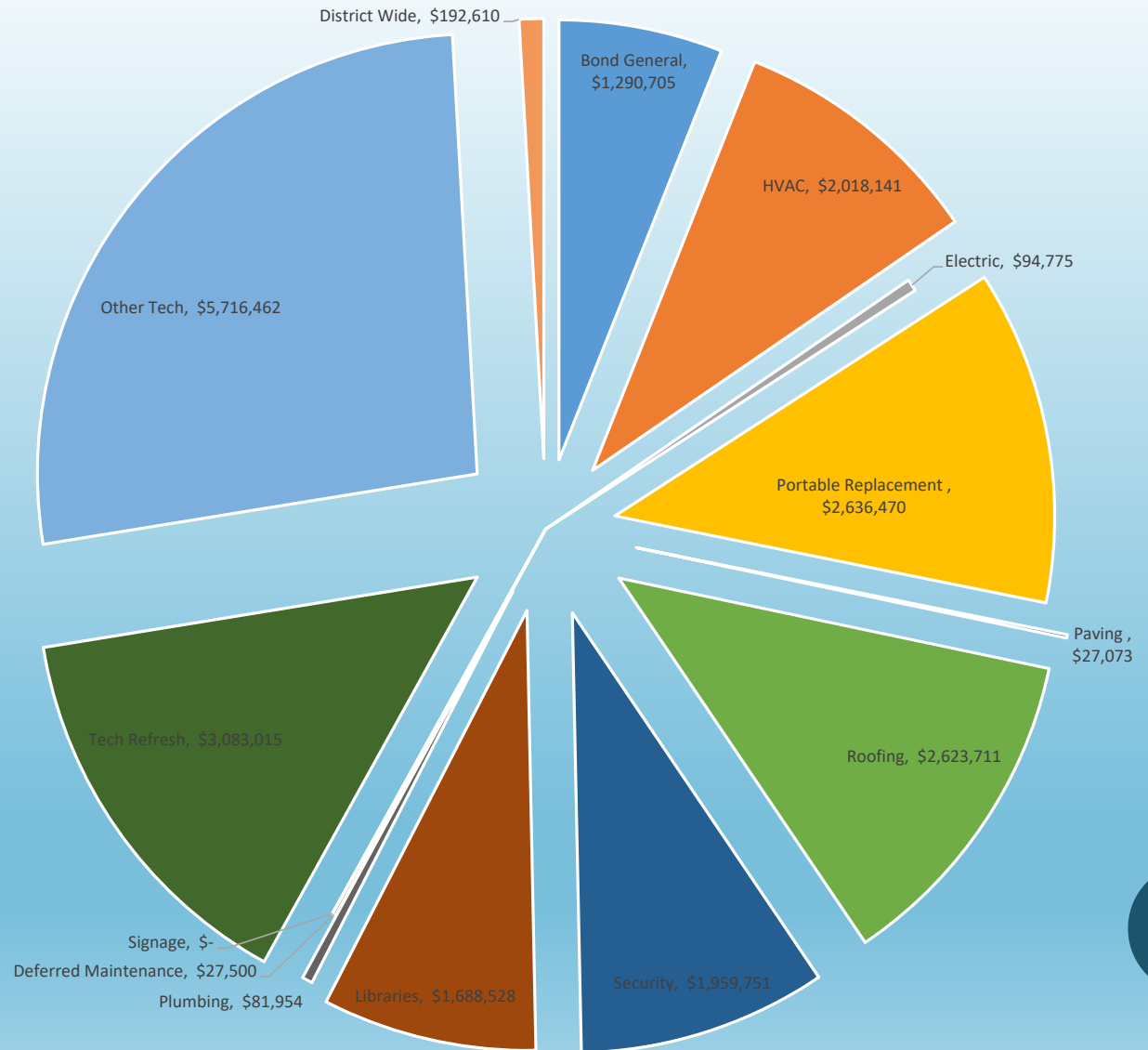

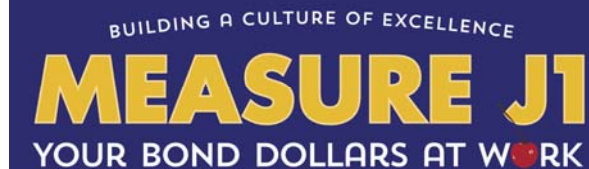
Citizens' Bond Oversight Committee
