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SLHS Student Agreement for Advanced Placement (AP)

Per San Leandro Unified School District Board Policy 6141.5, San Leandro High School supports students who want to challenge themselves academically, develop college-level skills, and be more competitive when applying for admission to postsecondary institutions by taking Advanced Placement (AP) courses and passing AP examinations.

Before enrolling in an AP course, students should be aware that they will be expected to:

- Be independent learners, willing to read, learn, ask questions, pursue outside reading and research, integrate and discuss material from diverse sources.
- Spend, on average, approximately five hours per week for each AP class.
- Accept that enrollment in an AP course does not guarantee an A or B grade.
- Meet all prerequisites or teacher approvals necessary for enrollment.

Before enrolling in an AP course, students and their parent/guardian must agree to, and sign the following contract:

1. I recognize that I have to demonstrate independence and responsibility. Each advanced placement course may require as much as five hours of homework weekly.
2. I understand I will not be able to transfer out of an AP course after the first progress reporting period.**
3. I realize that by enrolling in an Advanced Placement course, I am expected to take the corresponding Advanced Placement exam in May. Funding for this examination is available for those with demonstrated financial need.
4. I understand that it is expected that all work is original and that plagiarized work will lead to academic consequences.
