Volunteer Parent Driver Requirements

Thank you for volunteering to transport our student-athletes to away contest. Anyone volunteer transporting students is considered a Level 2 volunteer. Therefore, to ensure the safety of our children, below is a list of the level 2 requirements that must be met before you can be cleared to drive students to our athletic contest.

- 1) Complete a volunteer packet.
- 2) Complete the **Transportation of Students Form** (sometimes called Parent Driver Form)
- 3) Submit a **photocopy of your auto insurance policy** that shows the proper insurance coverage amounts. The minimums are listed on the Transportation of Students Form.
- 4) Submit a **photocopy of your valid CDL** (California Driver's License).
- 5) Submit proof of a passed **Tuberculosis TB test**. TB test are often offered for free at your doctor's office. Call your doctor and insurance company for details. Skin readings will occur 48-72 hours after the initial visit. TB test are valid for 4 years.
- 6) Pass a **fingerprint test**. See the Live Scan Information Sheets and the Request for Live Scan Service Sheet. Live Scan service is available at numerous locations (see https://oag.ca.gov/fingerprints/locations) but Tarrell Live Scan at 27526 Tampa Ave, Hayward, Ca only charges SLUSD volunteers \$47 for the service. Phone 510-786-9182
- -The Athletic Department will reimburse volunteer drivers for any TB test or fingerprint screening expenses, provided the receipts are submitted to the Athletic Director.
- -Bancroft's main office can assist with any necessary photocopies, or can provide the necessary forms. The forms are also available in numerous places on the district or school website, including the ATHLETICS pages. See Parent Driver Forms.
