Research Steps

- 1. DECIDE what information you need, and identify the key ideas
- 2. IDENTIFY the appropriate SOURCE (encyclopedia, book, internet, database)
- 3. SEARCH using the index, table of contents, and search boxes
- 4. READ your findings and use NOTE-TAKING STRATEGIES
- 5. CITE the SOURCE in the Bibliography /Works Cited page
