We are pleased to let you know that we will be conducting a District Survey. We will use the California Healthy Kids Survey for students. They also have surveys for Staff and Community. It is very important that between Feb. 4th and Feb. 15th you go online, go to our website, and complete the survey. Just go to our Monroe Website at <u>www.slusd.us/monroe</u> and look for the link to the survey. This is one very important way we collect data to create our school plan. So make sure to go online and take the survey. If you need access to a computer, Ms. J is available to assist.

We also have LCAP Community Input Nights coming up. We will have a Chinese Language LCAP Community Engagement Forum at Monroe on Feb. 26th. I will also be attending an LCAP Community Engagement Forum at John Muir on February 11th, which will be held in English. The meetings are from 6:30-8pm. Volunteers

A new application must be submitted every year. This is a board policy and everyone must comply whether you are volunteering one hour or every day. Please note that you may be asked to provide a current Tuberculosis (TB) screening and LiveScan Fingerprints dependent on the number of hours you plan to volunteer.

Reporting Absences

If your child is absent, you should always clear absences within 48 hours by either calling the attendance line 510-618-4341, sending a note to the office, or an email to: <u>lgomez@slusd.us</u> / <u>talonzo@slusd.us</u>. After three days of absences, you are required to provide a doctor's note to the office. <u>Tardy:</u> Any student not in class by 8:10 am will be marked tardy. If coming in after 8:10 am you will need to pass by the office and get yellow late pass date stamped by the office. If a parent/guardian picks up their child early from school for an appointment, we need a doctor's note to verify the appointment the next day.
