Volunteers

A new application must be submitted every year. This is a board policy and everyone must comply whether you are volunteering one hour or every day. Please note that you may be asked to provide a current Tuberculosis (TB) screening and LiveScan Fingerprints dependent on the number of hours you plan to volunteer.

Reporting Absences

After three days of absences, you are required to provide a doctor's note to the office. Tardy: Any student not in class by 8:10 am will be marked tardy. If a parent/guardian picks up their child early from school for an appointment, we need a doctor's note to verify the appointment the next day.
