JANUARY IS “RESPECT AND KINDNESS MONTH” AT ROOSEVELT **Join us in growing a “Garden of Kindness”!**

Greetings Roosevelt families-

For the month of January, Roosevelt is joining in the national observance of “No-Name Calling Week” and expanding it to an entire month! Please join us in celebrating “Respect and Kindness Month” at Roosevelt and beyond. This is a reminder that our school should be an environment where everyone feels safe and welcome, and where bullying is not tolerated. We expect all students to show kindness and respect towards all in our community.

During this month, your child’s teacher will be offering age-appropriate lessons on respect, kindness, and empathy. Each class will also participate in an art activity, culminating in a school-wide “Garden of Kindness” in the main hallway (to be installed this Friday Jan. 19 after school).

Here are some ways you can support the effort at home:

- Ask your child what they are learning in class about words and their impact during Respect and Kindness Month.
- Encourage your child to talk with you about their friendships. If your child shows signs of feeling left out, talk with them about it. Share a time when you felt the same way.
- Ask your child what they observe about kindness or unkindness in different school settings: on the playground, in the classroom, in the lunch room.
- Brainstorm ways your child can use kind language and respectful behavior at school.
- Consider reviewing your own behavior and language at home. Do you use negative terms for people who are different from you, or overlook it in others? Can you find ways to model more empathy and kindness at home?
- Stop by with your children to visit the Garden of Kindness in the main hallway, starting next week, to explore these themes further.

Please reach out to your child’s teacher with any ideas or concerns. Thank you for your support!
