We began learning about insects and students learned how to identify an insect (they were also very excited to learn the word "exoskeleton"). Our reading went well with our insect investigation, as we got to read <u>Fly Guy</u> in our reading book. Students completed their third math module, all about measurement, and brought their workbooks home this week, too. We began our new math module this past Thursday, which focuses on place value.

Next week, students will read about how animals interact with people. We will focus on how to make the long e sound in different ways with our spelling. Students will continue to learn about insects as they build their knowledge for their project. We will be talking about where insects live, what they eat, and how they protect themselves. In math, we will continue to work on place value and we will take a look at writing numbers in expanded form.
