Dear Parents,

I hope you had a wonderful week. We had another busy week in our room. This week, we learned about long i words, such as ride and bike. We read about how plants grow and change over time. Students read and wrote about Dr. King. They realized how Dr. King wanted us to share kindness and peace with each other. Students created Dr. King puppets and wrote a sentence that they think he would have said to them on their puppet. I will be sharing pictures of those on ClassDojo shortly. As we thought about Dr. King, the students wrote about who they felt was their hero. Today, we celebrated our classroom authors as students shared their hero writing pieces.

Next week, we will learn about words soft c and soft g sounds, as well as words that end in -dge. We will learn about folktales in our reading. In math, the class will continue to work on our subtraction skills, trying different strategies to solve our problems. We will also conclude our lessons about Dr. King with one final writing project. The class will then begin learning about American symbols and landmarks.
