In the last few years we have seen great growth in our AP programs, with several new AP courses and new elective classes being added to our curriculum. We strive to provide a challenging learning experience for all students.

Our AVID, SLAM (multimedia), Social Justice, and Business Academy continue to win awards and recognition: our Business Academy regularly sends students to national competitions to present their business plans. Our multimedia students are county award winners and their projects demonstrate industry standard skills. Our Social Justice Academy has become an award winning program. We continue to expand our AVID program to support our efforts to prepare students to enter a four year university upon graduation from high school.
